CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

- 1. The Camper, his/her parents, guardians and relatives agree to abide by the rules and regulations set by The Camp for the health, safety and welfare of The Camp and The Camper.
- 2. The Camper is entitled to one visit by his/her family during the Camp season on a Camp visit day.
- 3. No gratuities of any kind are permitted to be given to any member of the Camp staff.
- 4. By May 15th of the Camp year, the parent shall furnish the Camp with such information as the Camp deems necessary with regard to the Camper's health, education, interest and skills.
- 5. Since the financial organization of the Camp is on a seasonal basis and all salaries for chefs, counselors and other members of the staff and contracts for supplies and services are made in advance for the entire season, it is understood and agreed as follows:
 - A) No allowance shall be made for late arrival or for early departure of the Camper.
 - B) If enrollment of the Camper is cancelled prior to January 15th, of the Camp year, \$1500 of the payments theretofore made will be retained by the Camp to cover initial enrollment and administrative costs and the balance will be refunded.
 - C) If enrollment of the Camper is cancelled on or after January 15th, of the Camp year, all payments theretofore made will be retained by the Camp and the parent or guardian will remain liable for the balance of the tuition remaining, all of which shall be retained by the Camp as liquidated damages.
- 6. No extension of time for payment of tuition is permitted without prior written consent of the Camp, in its sole discretion. In the event of any dispute concerning late payment by the undersigned, the Camp shall be entitled to charge interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of 18% per annum and reimbursement from the undersigned for any court costs, attorney fees or collection fees.
- 7. The Camp is appointed to serve in loco parentis. Camper may use hazardous equipment, may participate in any activity/trip including horseback riding/water-skiing organized by the Camp staff on or off camp grounds and may travel, when deemed necessary by the Camp, via private or chartered carrier.
- 8. If it is necessary in the judgment of the Camp to use medical or dental aid for the Camper's health, the Camp is authorized to do so and all such expenses not covered by medical reimbursement insurance shall be paid by the parent or guardian.
- 9. Smoking/possession of or use of tobacco/narcotics/liquor or other intoxicant or non-prescription drug on or off the Camp grounds is expressly forbidden. Camper may not leave Camp grounds without the direct permission of the Camp Director. Violations of these rules or other reasonable regulations will result in dismissal from Camp without tuition rebate.
- 10. The Camp reserves the right in its sole discretion to dismiss a Camper whose conduct or influence is unsatisfactory or is in the opinion of the Camp, inimical to the best interests of the Camp. In that event, no refund of any portion of the Camp fee shall be made.
- 11. The Camp is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings, lost or damaged by fire, theft, laundry, or in any other manner.
- 12. In the event of destruction or damage to any property on the Camp, made by a Camper, the costs of repairs shall be borne by a parent or guardian.
- 13. The Camp reserves the right to use any comment (written or verbal) and/or any videos/photographs of any Camper or Staff member for Camp promotional materials.
- 14. A \$60 per week canteen/trip fund is required for each Camper. This is to provide for personal items, such as sundry and toilet articles, postage, canteen treats and for admission, transportation and supervision to activities that take place off the Camp grounds
- 15. A spending money fund deposit is suggested for each Camper. For extra treats and spending monies for off camp activities
